About us

In 2015, we acquired LF Eksperts, the Latvian outsourcing services leader, and BDO's team of financial advisers and auditors joined us. The mergers resulted in the establishment of Latvia's biggest audit and outsourcing service provider led by local partners.

Constant growth



Audit


